Hoosier Diamond would like to invite you to participate in the Hoosier Diamond Super 7 and Super 8 Summer League.

2010 will begin our 12<sup>th</sup> year conducting our summer league for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade teams.

The Super 7 and Super 8 league begins the first week of June and typically concludes the last week of June. Each team is guaranteed a total of 14 games (7 double headers). Games are scheduled on weekdays leaving your schedule available to participate in weekend invitational tournaments.

To be eligible to participate in this league your team must draw players from the same community...within your school district's geographical boundary.

Teams that participated last year were: New Palestine, Hamilton Heights, Columbus North, Bloomington North, Mt. Vernon (Fortville), Franklin Central, Lebanon, Warren Central, Mooresville, Martinsville, and Chatard.

**Games are played at each teams "home field."** If you do not have a "home field" Hoosier Diamond will work with you to help secure a field for your home games. We make every attempt possible to schedule half of your games on your home field.

**Hoosier Diamond schedules all games for the league and provides umpires.** Teams are responsible for providing baseballs for their home games.

The league schedule is built around your home field availability.

**Umpires are provided by the Indianapolis Umpire Association.** IUA is the largest umpire association in Indiana. Many of their umpires are top high school and college umpires. Hoosier Diamond uses IUA exclusively for events such as the Hoosier Diamond Indiana Mr. Baseball Classic, Hoosier Diamond Spring 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade League, Hoosier Diamond Fall Baseball League (the largest most successful fall baseball program in the Midwest), and various other baseball projects.

**As part of the Super 7 and Super 8 leagues your team is eligible to participate in the Hoosier Diamond Memorial Weekend Tournament.** Participating in this tournament is a great opportunity for your team to get an early look at the upcoming summer season and also play against competition outside of the summer league. Super 7 and Super 8 teams are provided with a **discounted tournament entry fee of \$175**. Non-league teams must pay a tournament fee of \$375.

The cost to participate in the Super 7 or Super 8 League is \$1175.00 Your registration fee includes scheduling and umpires

**Many communities and high school coach have used the Hoosier Diamond Super 7 and Super 8 league as part of their summer feeder program.** These coaches / communities have realized the importance of being able to provide players from their schools the opportunity to play together throughout the summer.

**The Super 7 and Super 8 leagues are enrollment grade based.** To be eligible to participate in the Super 7 league all players must be enrolled in the 7<sup>th</sup> grade during the 2009 – 2010 school year. To be eligible to participate in the Super 8 league all players must be enrolled in the 8<sup>th</sup> grade during the 2009 – 2010 school year.

I have attached a registration form, team roster form, and calendar to this packet. To register simply complete the registration form and return it with your deposit of \$300 to Hoosier Diamond, PO Box 190, Westfield, IN. 46074-0190. Your roster form will be due shortly before the start of the season. Later you will submit your calendar which will indicate dates your home field **is not available**. The balance of your league fees will be due in mid May. If you plan to enter the Memorial Weekend Tournament you must make sure to mark the appropriate box on the registration form.
